For those of you going to Lilies, or who may want to attend in the future, here is Countess Isadora's Lilies Camp Packing list.

Camp Structures and Related Necessities:

Tent-ground cloth, poles, stakes, hammer, interior rugs, ropes

Sunshade- poles, stakes, ridge pole, ropes, portable holes

Kitchen Tent- poles, stakes, ropes

Sleeping Gear:

Air mattresses, air pump, pillows, sheets, blankets and or sleeping bags, lamp, flashlights, patching gear

Dining Gear:

Table, table cover, chairs, banners, tiki torches, message board, plates cups, bowls, (enough for 3 meals), spoons, knives, some forks for kids, napkins, (for "nice" meals, shard wash cloth otherwise), stools

Cooking Gear:

Table, propane stove, propane gas (use up partials, get one new), matches (sealed in plastic), hot pads, fly swatter, kitchen timer, cutting board, towels, wash clothes, two dish pans, dish soap, rubber gloves, abrasive scrubber, cloth for draining dishes, serving spoons, ect. in tray, knives (2 large, 3-4 small, 1 serrated), vegetable steamer and pan, large stock pot, skillet, colander (for draining pasta!), hot water teakettle, serving bowls & platters, plastic zip lock bags in qt and gal sizes, 3-4 plastic bowls, paper towels, heavy duty string, scissors, trash bags, water containers & short hose, large "trivet", first aid kit, fire extinguisher, water/fire buckets, hanging lamps, batteries, wagon, spray bottle with water/bleach, sun screen, kleenex, water container stand, shovel, pit cover (trash can lid works), bungee cords, camera, bungee clothes line

Coolers:

Water cooler (spigot gott), Dried food small chest w/o drain) Cold food (medium cooler with drain)

Food:

Distilled water, ice

Packed lunch and supper for set up day --SIMPLE, no cook stuff

Breakfast stuff: Cereal, milk, fruit juice concentrate, instants, (Tea, coffee, cocoa, oatmeal, tang) yogurt, (6-8), margarine, cream cheese, jelly peanut butter

Big meal stuff:

pastas, rice, bread for first 2 days

vegetables and fruit for first 2 days

meal for first 1-2 days, various fixings

Light meal stuff

sausage, cheese, olives, pickles, fruit, raw vegetables dried meats and fruit, nuts :

Seasonings:

Salt, pepper, zesty Italian dressing, tabasco, wine vinegar, mustard

Plan no cook breakfast and lunch for packing/return day

Clothing and personal hygiene:

Five to Six outfits for each adult, 7-8 for each kid, packed in their respective rubbermaid tubs

Dirty clothes bag (pack bedding in on way down), laundry detergent, toy animals for kids

Misc: PJ's, hats, socks, underwear, foot gear, pants, under tunics, tunics, shirts, belts, swim gear

Soap and shampoo (combo rinse type), baby shampoo, (a Rubbermaid tub works for baby bath tub), bath toys, towels (2 per person), combs, "shower"basket (not bothered by getting

wet)cornstarch or baby powder, deodorant

Any meds.... in first aid kit, vitamins

Toys and Books

Chess set, jousting guys, legos(castle and tree minus really tiny pieces???), small chairs, little table, drawing paper and markers, small balls, kite?, books books,

Fighting Gear:

All of it!! Plus repair kit!

Ceremonial Stuff:

Brass hats, medallions, chain, white belt(s),fighting tabards

Baronial party stuff? Largess? Favors?
